The Toledo Zoo's **main entrance** is located on Anthony Wayne Trail at Hippo Way between South Avenue and Harvard Blvd / Woodsdale Avenue.

The **south entrance** is located at 2700 Broadway Street, across from Walbridge Park.

Zoo Hours:

The Zoo is open every day of the year except Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Year's Day.

10:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. May 1 – Labor Day
10:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. Day after Labor Day – April 30

Lights Before Christmas hours:

Monday through Thursday 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
Friday through Sunday 5:00 p.m. – 9:00 p.m.

Visitors have one hour after the gates close to complete their visit.



Admission:

\$11.00 for Adults

\$8.00 for Children (2 yrs. - 11 yrs.) and Seniors (60+)

FREE for Zoo Members and Children under 2 years.

Military Discounts - Show your military ID at the admission gate and receive FREE admission. Immediate family members are eligible for the group rate discount. For family members of military personnel who are currently serving, please show your dependent card at the admission gate to be eligible for the group rate

Group rate discounts are also available for groups of 20 or more when purchased in advance. Please contact the Group Sales Department at (419) 385-5721, ext. 3092, for details.

With valid ID, all Lucas County residents receive free admission every Monday (except holidays) from 10:00 a.m. until noon.

Please note: At times, some of the animal exhibits may be closed to meet the varying needs of Zoo animals. We apologize for the inconvenience.



Parking:

\$6.00 per vehicle

Members must present a Toledo Zoo membership card to receive free parking in the Anthony Wayne Trail lot.

\$10.00 for RVs, campers, motor coaches or any vehicle that takes up more than one parking space.

* Please note that large vehicles may be asked to park in the rear of the parking lot.

Amusement Ride Ticket Prices:

African Animal Carousel (indoors): **\$1.50**
Safari Railway: **\$2.00**
Historic South Side Carousel: **\$1.00**

Hours of ride operation vary according to season and weather conditions.



Rentals:

Stroller: **\$3.50** *Wheelchair: **\$5.00**
Wagon: **\$5.00** *Motorized scooter: **\$20.00**

* The Zoo requires a valid ID before wheelchairs and scooters can be rented. Visitors are encouraged to reserve a motorized scooter prior to their visit.

Reservations can be made by phone at 419-389-6561.

A limited number of scooters are available for rental.



Guest Policies:

- The Toledo Zoo is a smoke-free facility. If you exit the Zoo to smoke, please have your hand stamped at the ticket booth for re-entry when you return.
- Please do not feed animals.
- Solicitation for any purpose is not permitted.
- Pets are not allowed on Zoo grounds. (*assistance dogs are permitted for physically challenged people*)
- Alcoholic beverages are prohibited on Zoo grounds.
- Shirts and footwear must be worn at all times.
- Commercial photography or filming is prohibited without the prior consent of the Zoo's Marketing & PR Department.
- While on Zoo grounds you may be photographed or filmed as part of our publicity efforts.
- The Toledo Zoo is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- No rain checks or refunds will be issued.
- No climbing on barriers or walls.

Items that are prohibited on Zoo grounds:

Pets, firearms, glass containers, grills or hibachis, laser pointers, drinking straws, balloons, skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, scooters, roller skates, roller skate shoes, radios or CD players

Guest Services:

- For assistance with First Aid, proceed to the Bear Essentials shop on the north side, or the Museum of Science Administration Office on the south side.
- Lost children found by Zoo staff will be taken to the Museum of Science Administration Office (south side).
- Lost & Found is located in the Visitor Services Center on the north side in the main entry complex
- Ohio Relay Service is available for the hearing impaired in the Museum of Science Administration Office.
- In the event of severe weather, it is recommended that guests seek shelter in the closest building, away from windows and doors. Zoo staff and security will also assist in guiding guests to safety until conditions have improved.
- Zoo maps are available at both gates to help visitors locate exhibits, buildings, concessions, gift shops, and souvenir stands.
